CAMP GUIDELINES

- All campers have to be present for the entire week of camp. There is no coming and going unless it is an emergency.
- Campers will always be under adult staff and camp leader supervision
- If there is a problem with a camper, the camp director will work directly with the camp staff from camper's church to bring resolution
- Youth age 17 and up who plan to be Children's Camp leaders MUST attend Youth Camp.
 Spots are limited. Please be advised that some may not be accepted. LEADER
 APPLICATIONS DEADLINE: JULY 3rd.
- We are limited on the number of leader positions. Please be advised that some may not be accepted. LEADER APPLICATIONS DEADLINE: JULY 3rd.

WHAT TO BRING

Bible, notebook and pen, camp clothes, old clothes (for messy games), swimsuit (one-piece/tankini), sandals AND tennis shoes, toiletries, towels (bath and beach), insect repellent, sunscreen, hat and sunglasses, 1 pair of jeans and jacket (for cool weather), flashlight with batteries, sleeping bag, twin sheets, blanket, pillow, and plastic bags for dirty and wet clothes, life jacket and water bottle.

DRESS CODE

All campers and staff should always wear modest clothes. Do not wear clothes displaying distasteful slogans or ads for products such as alcohol and tobacco. All shirts should have some sort of sleeve. **Guys**: No muscle shirts and KEEP YOUR PANTS PULLED UP. **Girls:** No camis or tank tops. No short shorts. No yoga or cheerleading shorts/pants. No pants with writing on the back side. Please do not wear tight or revealing tops. ONLY modest one piece bathing suits or modest tankinis that cover everything. NO bikinis or one-piece suits that resemble a bikini.

Camp Staff will be responsible for making sure guidelines are communicated and met while attending camp. The director has the final say concerning issues related to the dress code.

WHAT NOT TO BRING

No alcohol or tobacco products, non prescription drugs, fireworks, firearms, or any weapons, radios, cell phones, laser pointers, iPods, DS, tablets, laptops, water guns, and shaving cream (for shaving purposes only).

BACKGROUND CHECKS

Crossroads Baptist Assocation requires ALL camp staff (18 years and older) to submit a background check application for a minimal fee of \$5.95. Background Check deadline is JULY 14th, 2024 and will need to be renewed every 3 years. Camp staff that do not have a current background check will not be permitted to camp.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- In order to keep our camp safe and well supervised, we require each sponsoring church to provide **ONE** staff leader per **FIVE** campers attending camp.
- Students will be assigned to cabins by gender and grade, **NOT** by church.
- If a camper wants to be with a certain person, please note that on the registration form. We will do our best to accommodate each request.

FIRST AID AND MEDICAL INFORMATION

A qualified camp nurse will be available to all campers and staff. All prescriptions must be in their original container and must be accompanied by a copy of the writtend prescription from the physician Camper must place all prescriptions and medications in a Ziploc Bag and give it to the camp nurse at registration. The camp nurse will dispense all prescriptions and medications at appropriate times. Having accurate emergency contact infromation is essential for each camper and staff. A copy of camper's insurance card must accompany thier registration.
